215 telecoms towers in Perak deemed illegal, says exco man

KAMPAR: A total of 215 telecommunications towers have been identified as having been illegally built in Perak, says state communications, multimedia and NGO committee chairman Mohd Azlan Helmi.

He said the towers were found to have been built in 12 areas in the state without adhering to guidelines set by local authorities, including district and land offices.

"However, there are still those who have failed to do so," he told a press conference after officiating Pesta Persatuan Sukan dan Kebudayaan Perkhidmatan Pendidikan Perak 2023 here on Friday (Oct 13).

The highest number was found in Ipoh with 83, followed by Manjung and Taiping (31 each); Teluk Intan (14); Kuala Kangsar and Tanjung Malim (12 each); Kerian (nine); Tapah (eight); Batu Gajah (six); Kampar and Perak Tengah (four each); and Gerik (one), he added.

Mohd Azlan said the authorities will issue compound notices and take strict actions to prevent the unauthorised construction of telecommunications towers in the state.

He also urged the public to channel information on the construction of illegal towers in their respective areas to Digital Perak and the state Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC). – Bernama
